We discussed the flyer/quote that was left on the church from Caton Asphalt. We decided to do some research and entertain bids. We also discussed we need to do some painting here and there on the church building.

We discussed how pleased we are with our Pastor Lee and the dedication she gives to our church. Lee has been a part time pastor for the past couple of years. Well, for 2024 she is going to be able to give us 3/4 time and is planning to be at the church doing whatever is needed one day a week. Yay! That being said we voted to increase her pay.

We also went over policies and procedures for the church for 2024 and agreed to try and have special music more often.

Caton warranties his work for 5 years. So, the board decided to contract with Caton to do crack fill, patch the holes, sealcoat and line striping.

Our board meetings are open and all are welcome to attend. Our next meeting is scheduled for January 21, 2024 at 2 p.m.



#### LOADED CAULIFLOWER CASSEROLE

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 2 lbs cauliflower florets, cut to bite sized pieces
- 8 oz. cream cheese softned
- 1/2 cup sour cream
- 11/2 cup cheddar cheese
- 11/2 cup mexican shredded cheese
- 8 slices bacon, crispy cooked and chopped
- garlic powder, onion powder, salt and pepper to taste

#### Directions:

Steam the cauliflower until fork tender; approximately 10 minutes. Drain well in a colander. Preheat oven to 425 degrees. Grease a 9x13 baking dish. In a large bowl, combine the cream cheese, sour cream, chesses, and seasoning. Mix until creamy and smooth. Gently stir in cauliflower, and 3/4 of the bacon. Spoon into the casserole dish and top with the remaining bacon. Bake uncovered for 20-25 minutes or until the cheese is melted.


